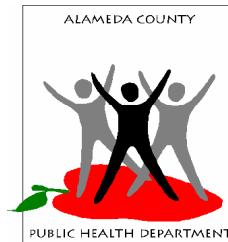

DREAMS is implemented by the Maternal, Paternal, Child and Adolescent Health (MPCAH) Program of the Alameda County Public Health Department.



Purpose of the Program

The purpose of DREAMS

is to:

- Improve birth outcomes
- Improve health of women and couples before conception or during pregnancy
- Prevent premature labor.

Population Served

High risk and underserved women with a history of fetal or infant loss, previous low or very low birth-weight infant, and/or previous premature delivery.

Services Provided

- Assessment and referral
- Assistance with linkages and access to care
- Bereavement support
- Case management/care coordination in person or by telephone
- Community site visits by staff
- Information, education and outreach
- Accompaniment to providers
- Culturally competent bilingual services. (Spanish/MAM)
