

What You Need To Know About Private Universities!



PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES offer several degrees, certificates, and credentials consisting of Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral degrees. This is a 4 - year university that is the most prestigious and well-known type of school in the world. Every member of the Ivy League is a private university.

* The term "private" simply means that the university's funding comes from tuition, investments and private donors, not from taxpayers.

Cost of Tuition & Other Expenses: ~ \$40,000/year.

PAYING FOR COLLEGE

FAFSA: Determine your eligibility for Federal grants and loans to help pay for college.

* Some schools may require its completion.

Scholarships: Money awarded to a student to help them complete their goals. Sign up online at <http://www.fastweb.com/> to be matched with scholarships.

* Scholarships can be offered by any institution, including your school of choice.
