SAT TEST, is a standardized test that is used by most colleges and universities, AT THIS MOMENT, THE SAT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR COLLEGE ENTRANCE in California. The SAT has been used to compare applicants from different schools and states, in finalizing admissions decisions. The SAT test covers the following criteria: Math, Reading (Evidence-Based Reading), Writing and Language. The exam is scored in two categories: Math and Evidence-Based Reading/Language. For each category, the highest possible score is 800. The highest possible total score is therefore 1,600. Unlike the ACT test, the SAT is heavily concentrated on demonstrating your reading and grammar skills.

COSTS AND FEE WAIVERS

Fee Waivers report out your scores to your high school, and up to 4 colleges

- SAT test costs \$55
- In order to qualify for a fee waiver you must meet the following requirements:
- Currently enrolled in high school in the 11th or 12th grade
- Either a United States citizen or testing in the US, US territories, or Puerto Rico
- Meet one or more indicators of economic need listed on the ACT Fee Waiver Form

You must contact your high school counselor to request Fee Waiver Form

ACT TEST, is a standardized test that is used by most colleges and universities, AT THIS MOMENT, THE ACT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR COLLEGE ENTRANCE in California. The ACT has been used to compare applicants from different schools and states, in finalizing admissions decisions. The ACT test covers the following criteria: English, Reading, Math and Science, as well as Writing component (optional). Each section is graded on a scale from 1-36 and a composite score (which is an average of all 4 criteria). If you decide to take the writing section, it will be combined with the English score. School admissions will typically look at the composite score.

- *ACT test with writing costs \$88.00
