What You Need To Know About Going To A University of California!









UNIVERSITIES OF CALIFORNIA, (UC's) are

federally-funded public schools that offer several degrees, certificates, and credentials consisting of Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral degrees. This is a 4-year university, but it is possible to transfer to a UC after going to community college or state school for 2 years.

* <u>UCs</u> are public schools that are more selective than CSU's and harder to get in to. Cost of Tuition & Other Expenses: ~ \$38,000/year.

PAYING FOR COLLEGE

FAFSA: Determine your eligibility for Federal grants and loans to help pay for college.

* Some schools may require its completion.

Scholarships: Money awarded to a student to help them complete their goals. Sign up online at http://www.fastweb.com/ to be matched with scholarships.

* Scholarships can be offered by any institution, including your school of choice.
