Community economic development that supports the ability of all residents, regardless of race/ethnicity or place of residence, to pay for all of their basic needs (including housing, food, transportation, healthcare, and childcare) and build wealth.

Community economic development:

- Equitable

- Entrepreneurship training & support

Pay for Basic Needs:

- Diversity of workforce reflects community demographics
- Livable wage (self-sufficiency index)
- Labor force participation

Build Wealth:

- Locally owned business - Local entrepreneurship support/training entry into vacant commercial space

Economics:

- % of locally owned business
- % of high school graduates meeting
- % of local entrepreneurs
- % of vacant commercial space
- % of open child care slots

- College completions
- % FAFSA Applications- successful completion of financial aid applications

- Affordable housing

- Living wage
- Advancement towards equity
- (Self sufficiency wage)
