- Practice using mobility devices!

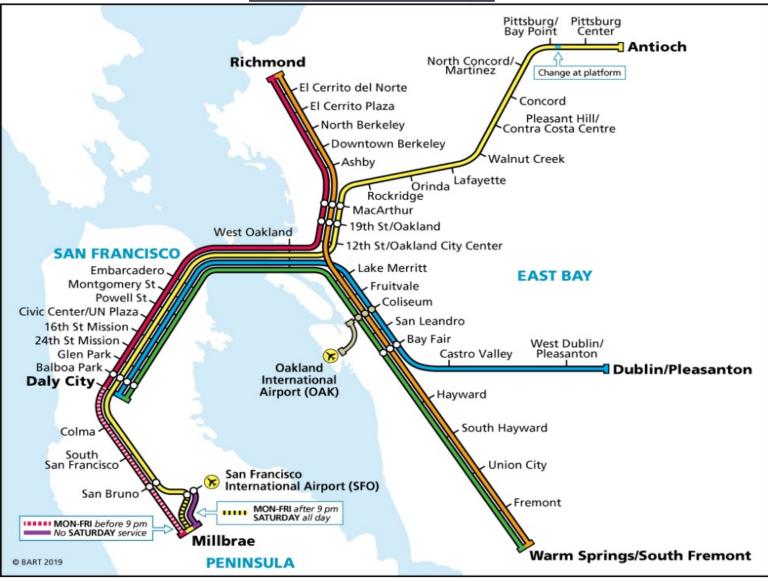
Types of Transportation
