NEW! Rate Changes due to Minimum Wage Increase effective July 1, 2014.

Due to the enactment of Assembly Bill 10 AB10, minimum wage will increase to \$9.00 per hour effective July 1, 2014. As a result, RCEB vendors may be eligible for a rate adjustment in order to pay employees the new minimum wage. The Department of Developmental Services (DDS) has established processes for eligible vendors to request rate adjustments specific to this minimum wage increase.
