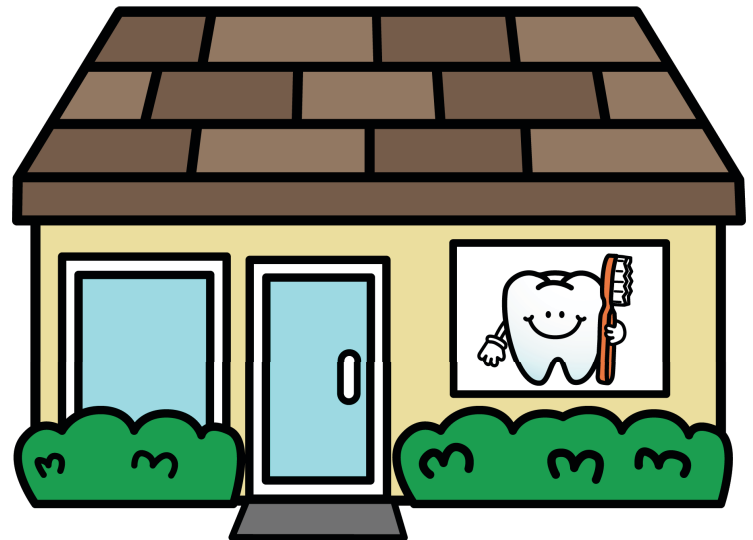


What will I see at the dentist?



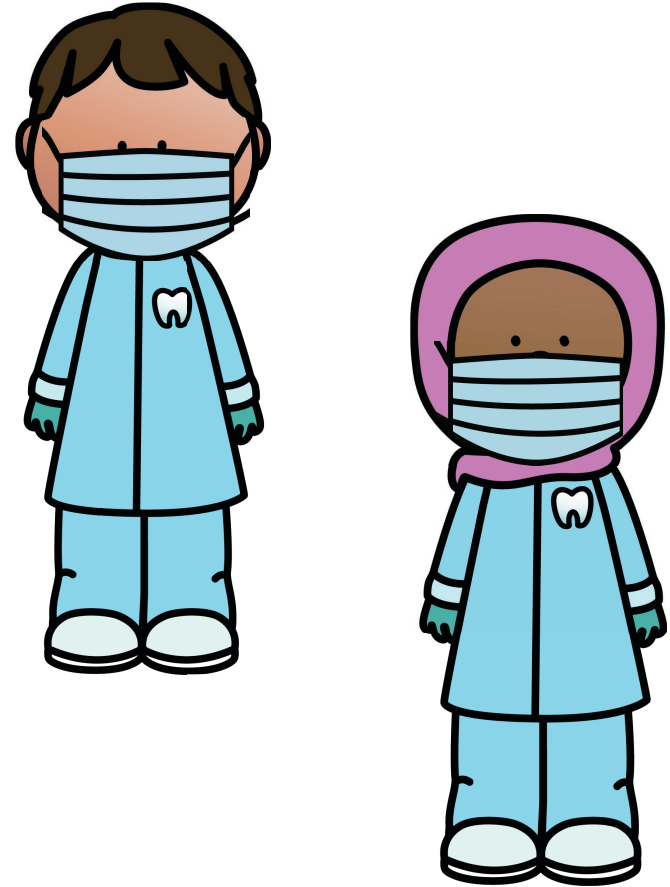
A COVID-19 Related Story



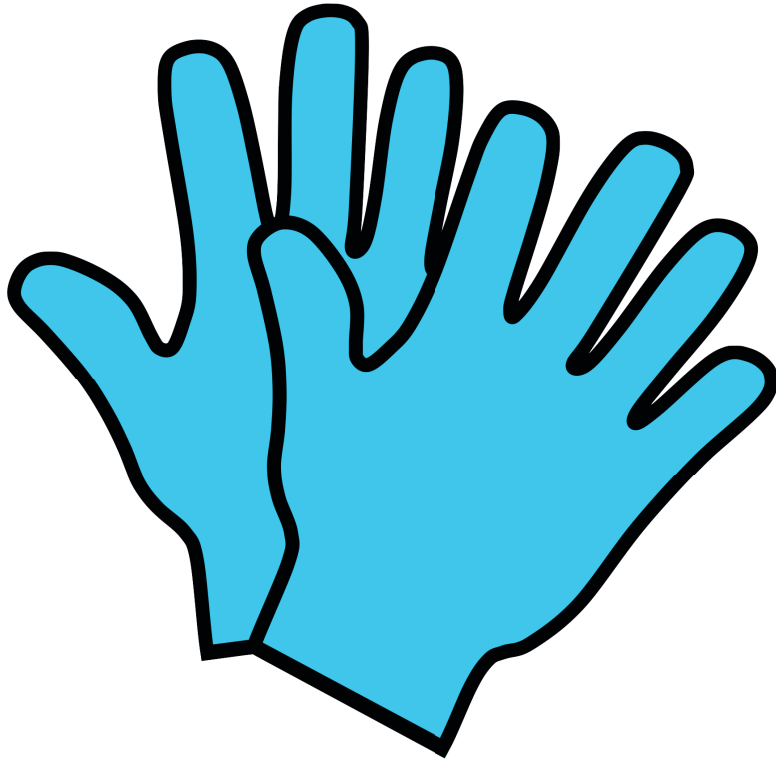
It is time to go to the dentist.



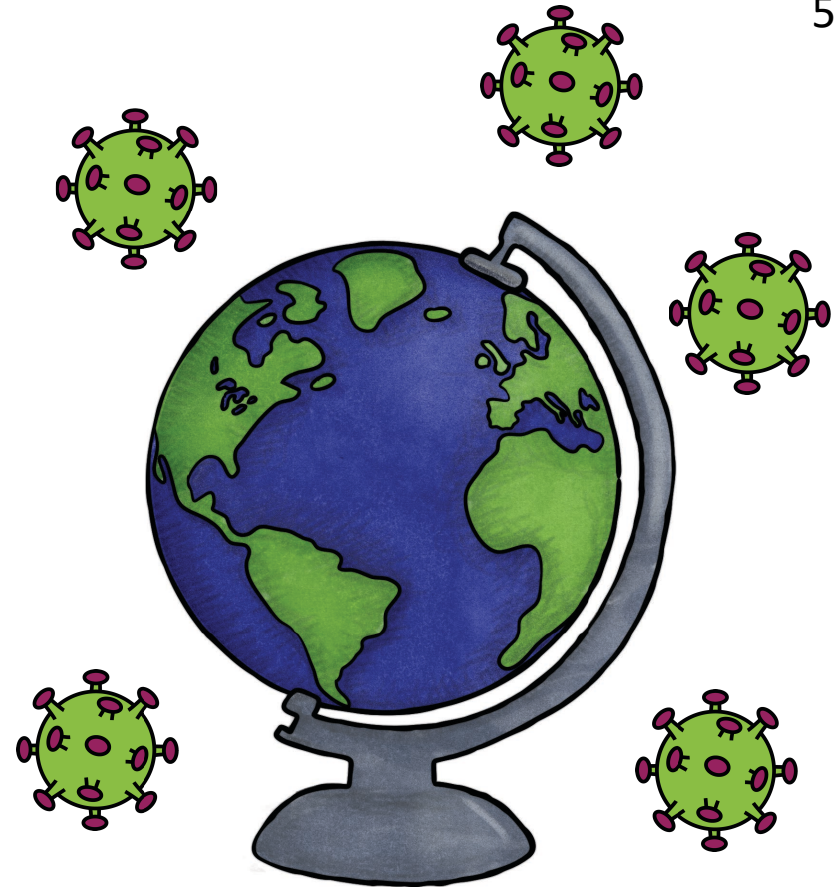
A dentist is someone who helps take care of my teeth and make sure my mouth is healthy.



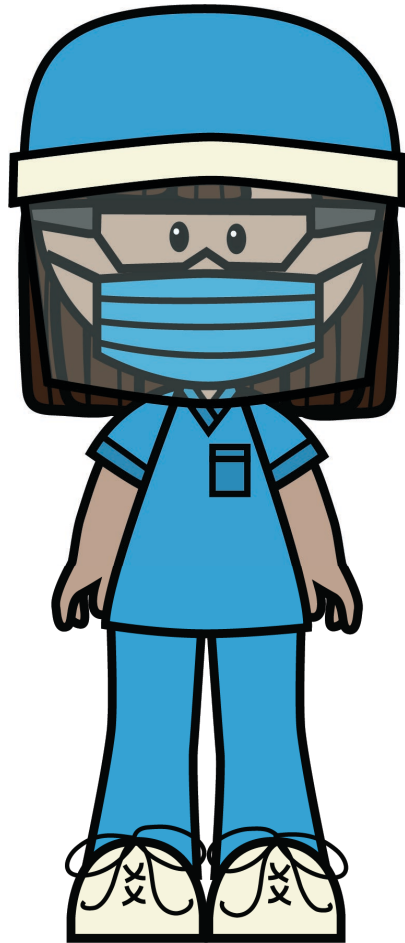
Usually, the dentist and hygienist will wear a mask over their mouth when they are looking at my teeth.



They also wear gloves to make sure germs don't get in my mouth or on their hands.



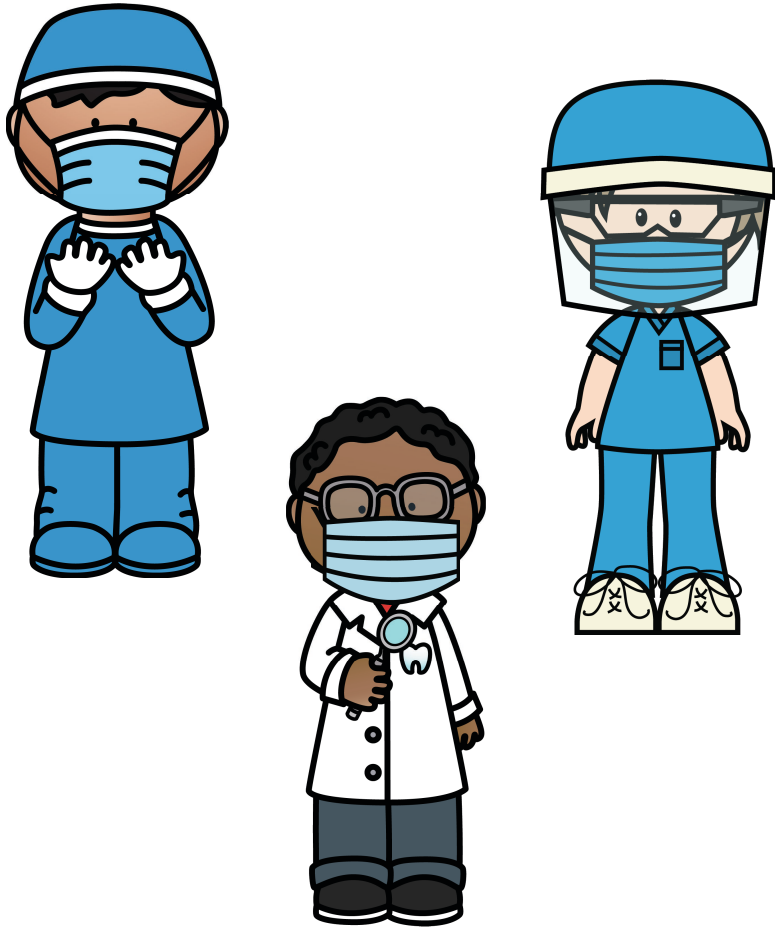
Now that Coronavirus has spread around the globe, I might see some new things at the dentist.



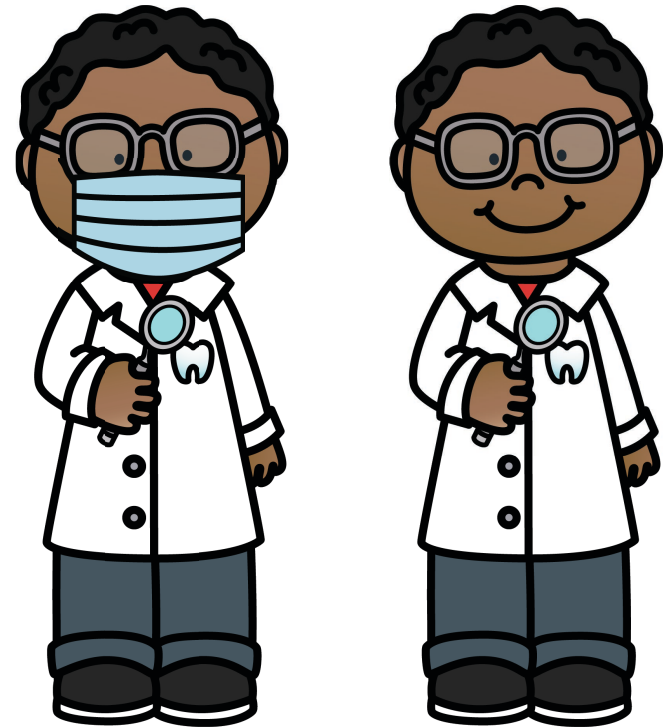
When I go to the dentist, I might see the workers wearing more protection, like a face shield. This protects us from germs and viruses.

I will get used to seeing more masks, gloves, face shields and other equipment at the dentist.



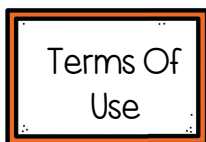
Under the mask and face shield, my dentist and hygienist are probably smiling at me.

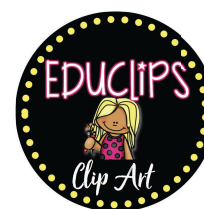
