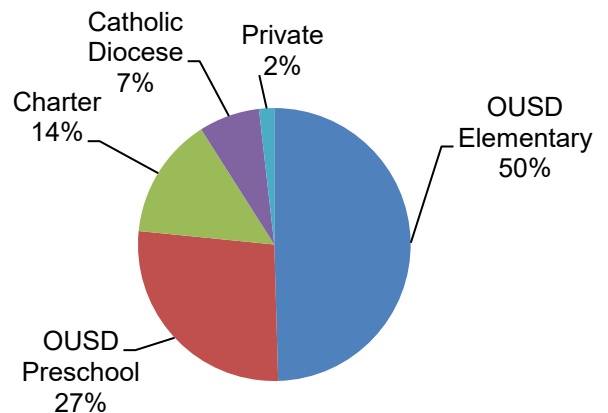
26% Average student participation rate for all schools

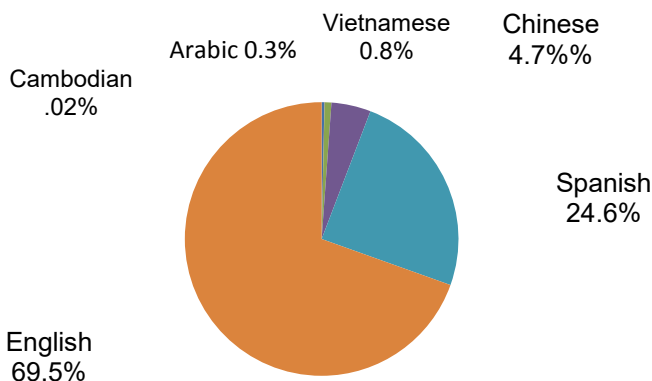
