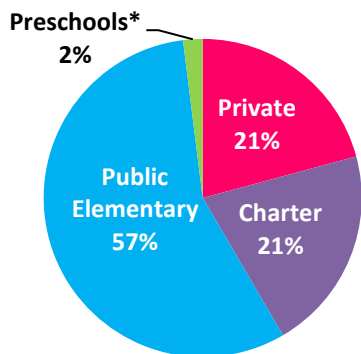


Shoo the Flu is a program to provide free in-school flu vaccinations for Oakland-area elementary students with parent consent.

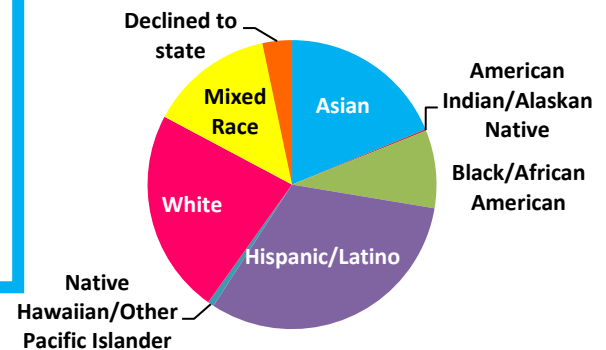

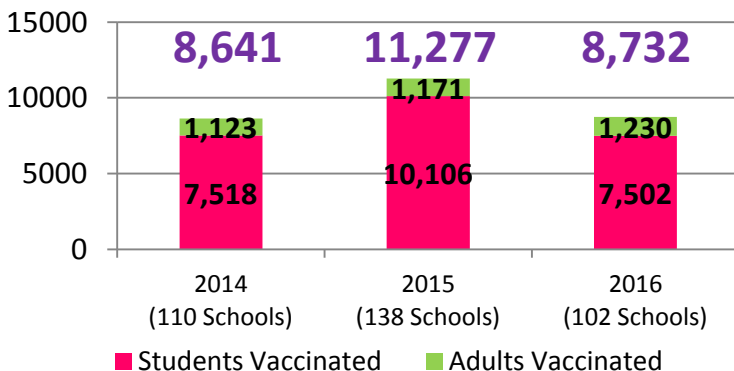
The CDC did not recommend nasal spray flu vaccine for the 2016-17 season. All clinics were injection-only for the first time in 2016.
