Shoo the Flu is a program that provides free in-school flu vaccinations for students in Oakland.

7,536
students vaccinated
8,815 total vaccines given
(including school staff)

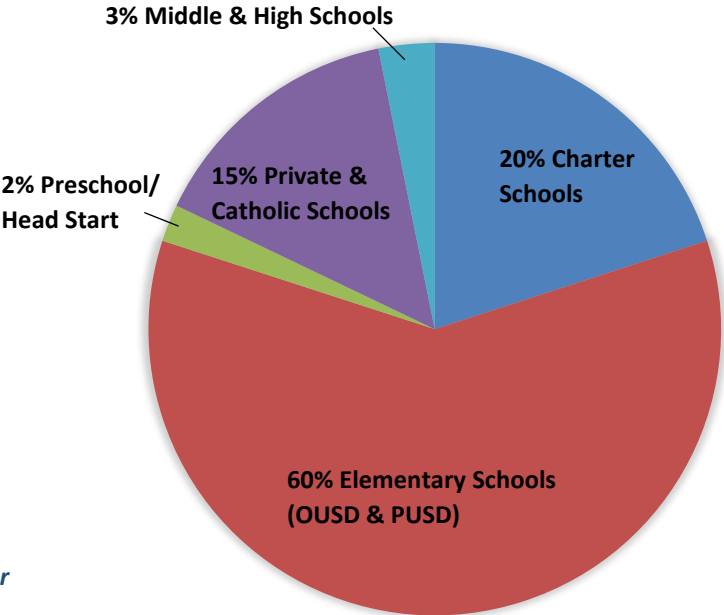
40% of vaccines administered were for uninsured/low-income students

Schools averaged a **21%** participation rate
(Range: 4% to 58%)

Since 2014, we have provided **37,465** flu vaccines to students and school staff
