## What are safer practices and products?

#### A recognized salon has committed to the following:

- o Requiring all nail technicians to use nitrile gloves and appropriate respiratory protection
- o Setting up a designed well-ventilated area with a ventilation unit for artificial nails services to reduce harmful fume and dust indoor

#### Polishes and Lacquers without:

- o Toluene
- o Dibutyl phthalate
- o Formaldehyde

#### Nail Polish Thinners without:

- o Toluene
- o Methyl ethyl ketone (MEK)

#### Nail Polish Removers without:

o Ethyl or butyl acetate

#### Artificial Nails without:

o Methyl methacrylate
