Breakfast Burrito

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 1/3 cup black beans, cooked, mashed with 1 teaspoon canola oil, or use canned vegetarian refried beans
- 2 Tbsp. red onion, chopped
- ¹/₂ cup tomatoes, chopped
- 4 corn tortillas
- ¹/₂ cup salsa, low sodium
- 4 Tbsp. yogurt, non-fat plain
- 2 Tbsp. cilantro, chopped

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Mix beans with onion and tomatoes.

2. Microwave tortillas between the two sheets of slightly damp white paper towels on high for 15 seconds.

- 3. Divide bean mixture between the tortillas.
- 4. Fold each tortilla to enclose filling.
- 5. Place on microwave-safe dish and spoon salsa over each burrito.
- 6. Microwave on high for 15 seconds.
- 7. Serve topped with yogurt and cilantro.

Mango Chile Relleno al Carbón

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 small poblano peppers
- 2 large mangos peeled, pitted, and sliced, divided
- 4 Tbsp. of reduced fat cheddar & monterey jack shredded cheese
- 1/4 red onion, finely chopped
- 1/4 cup green bell pepper, chopped
- 1 Tbsp. lime juice
- 1 Tbsp. fresh cilantro, finely chopped
- 1/2 Tbsp. canned chipotle peppers in adobe sauce, finely chopped

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Put poblano pepper in the oven and broil for a few minutes on each side to blacken skin. Place in a small paper bag and fold over the top; let stand for 5 minutes.
- 2. Rub off skins and carefully cut open to remove seeds, leaving stems attached.
- 3. Place about 2/3 of the mango slices inside peppers then place 1 tablespoon of cheese in each.
- 4. Chop remaining mango & place in a medium bowl with all remaining ingredients for the mango salsa.
- 5. Place stuffed peppers on a foil-lined baking sheet. Bake at 425F for 5 minutes or until cheese is melted.
- 6. Remove from oven and cover in mango salsa.

Chicken Vegetable Soup with Kale

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 tsp. vegetable oil
- ¹/₂ cup onion, chopped
- ¹/₂ cup carrot, chopped
- 1 tsp. thyme, ground
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 2 cups water, or chicken broth
- ³/₄ cup tomatoes, diced
- ¹/₂ cup brown rice, cooked
- 1 cup chicken, cooked, skinned and cubed
- 1 cup kale, chopped

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Heat oil in a medium saucepan. Add onion and carrot. Sauté until vegetables are tender, about 5-8 minutes.
- 2. Add thyme and garlic. Sauté for one more minute.
- 3. Add water or broth, tomatoes, cooked rice, chicken and kale.
- 4. Simmer for 5-10 minutes.

Wonderful Stuffed Potatoes

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 potatoes (medium, baking)
- 3/4 cup cottage cheese (low-fat)
- 1/4 cup milk (low-fat 1%)
- 2 tablespoons margarine (soft tub)
- 1 teaspoon dill weed
- 3/4 teaspoon herb seasoning
- 1/4 teaspoon hot pepper sauce (or ~ 4 dashes)
- 2 tablespoons Parmesan cheese

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Prick potatoes with fork. Bake at 425 °F for 60 minutes or until fork is easily inserted.
- 2. Cut potatoes in half lengthwise. Carefully scoop out potato, leaving about 1/2 inch of pulp inside shell. Mash pulp in large bowl.
- 3. Mix in by hand remaining ingredients except Parmesan cheese. Spoon mixture into potato shells.
- 4. Sprinkle top with 1/4 teaspoon of Parmesan cheese.
- 5. Place on baking sheet and return to oven. Bake 15 to 20 minutes or until tops are golden brown.

Spaghetti with Turkey Meat Sauce

INGREDIENTS:

- Nonstick cooking spray
- ³⁄₄ lb. lean ground turkey
- 2 (14 ½ oz.) cans diced tomatoes, save juice
- 1 green bell pepper, finely chopped
- 1 cup onion, finely chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, finely chopped
- 1 tsp. dried oregano, crushed
- 1 tsp. ground black pepper
- 1 lb. spaghetti noodles

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Spray a large skillet with nonstick cooking spray. Preheat skillet over medium heat.
- 2. Add turkey and cook, stirring occasionally for 5 to 10 minutes or until cooked through. Drain fat.
- 3. Stir in tomatoes with their juice, bell pepper, onion, garlic, oregano, and ground black pepper. Bring to a boil and reduce heat. Cover and simmer for 15 minutes, stirring occasionally.
- 4. Meanwhile, cook spaghetti according to package directions; drain well. Serve sauce over spaghetti.

Tortilla Pizzas

INGREDIENTS:

- 12 corn tortillas, small (or flour tortillas)
- 1 tsp vegetable oil (or margarine)
- 1 can refried beans, fat-free, low-sodium (16 ounce)
- 1/4 cup onion (chopped)
- 2 ounces fresh or canned green chili peppers (diced)
- 3 Tbsp. red taco sauce
- 3 cups vegetables, such as broccoli, mushrooms, spinach, and red bell pepper (chopped)
- 1/2 cup cheese, shredded part-skim mozzarella
- 1/2 cup cilantro (chopped, fresh) (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Brush one side of each of two tortillas with water. Press the wet sides of the tortillas together to form a thick crust for the pizza.
- 2. Brush the outside of the tortillas with a small amount of oil or margarine. Evenly brown both sides in a heated frying pan. Repeat with the rest of the tortillas. Set aside.
- 3. Heat refried beans, onion, and half of the chili peppers together in a medium saucepan, stirring occasionally. Remove from heat.
- 4. Spread about 1/3 cup of the bean mixture on each tortilla pizza. Sprinkle with 1 tablespoon taco sauce, then top with 1/2 cup of the chopped vegetables, 1 teaspoon chili peppers, and 1 tablespoon cheese for each pizza.
- 5. Return to frying pan and heat until cheese melts. Top with cilantro, if desired. Serve immediately.

Zesty Asian Chicken Salad

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cooked and chilled
- 3 green onions, sliced
- 1¹/₂ cups small broccoli florets
- 2 medium carrots, peeled and cut into strips
- 1 red bell pepper, cut into strips
- 2 cups cabbage, shredded
- ½ cup fat-free Asian or sesame seed salad dressing
- ¹/₄ cup 100% orange juice
- ¼ cup fresh cilantro, chopped

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut chicken breast into small strips and place in medium bowl with onions, broccoli, carrots, bell peppers and cabbage.
- 2. In a small bowl, stir together dressing and juice.
- 3. Pour over salad and toss well to coat. Stir in cilantro.
- 4. Serve chilled or at room temperature.

Caribbean Crunch Slaw

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Tbsp. cilantro
- 2 Tbsp. lime juice
- 1 Tbsp. cider vinegar
- 1 Tbsp. sugar
- 4 cups purple cabbage, shredded
- 1 large mango, cut into slices

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a large bowl mix cilantro, lime juice, cider vinegar, and sugar.
- 2. Add cabbage and mango. Toss well.

Scrambled Tofu

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 (20 oz.) package tofu
- 1 Tbsp. butter
- 2 eggs
- pepper, to taste
- Add assorted veggies (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Drain tofu. In a small bowl, dice or mash tofu. For optional ingredients, crush garlic and /or slice the veggies.
- 2. In a pan, melt butter. Add tofu. Add optional ingredients. Sauté over medium heat until lightly browned.
- 3. Beat eggs and add to tofu mixture. Cook until firm.
- 4. Sprinkle with pepper to taste.
- 5. Stir and cook until firm.

Garden Stir-Fry

INGREDIENTS:

- ½ cup chicken broth, low sodium
- ½ Tbsp. cornstarch
- 1 tsp soy sauce, low sodium
- 1 Tbsp. sesame oil
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tsp ginger, freshly grated
- 2 cups broccoli
- 1¹/₄ cups yellow squash, chopped
- 1¹/₄ cups carrots, cut into matchsticks
- 1¹⁄₄ cups sugar snap peas
- 1 cup onion, sliced
- 1 cup red bell pepper, sliced

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a medium bowl, whisk together chicken broth, cornstarch, & soy sauce. Set aside.
- 2. In a sauté pan over moderately high heat, warm the sesame oil. Add garlic & ginger. Cook for 1 minute.
- 3. Add the vegetables and cook until tender, 7 to 10 minutes.
- 4. Add the soy sauce mixture, reduce heat to moderate and continue cooking until the sauce is thickened

Dessert

Zucchini Muffins

INGREDIENTS:

- nonstick cooking spray
- 2 eggs
- ¹/₂ cup applesauce
- ¹/₄ cup granulated sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1¹⁄₄ cups whole wheat flour
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1 tsp baking soda

- 1¹/₂ tsp ground cinnamon
- ½ tsp ground ginger
- ¼ tsp ground cloves
- 2 cups grated zucchini (about 2 small zucchinis)
- ¹/₂ cup raisins
- ²/₃ cup pecans or walnuts, toasted and chopped

INSTRUCTIONS :

- 1. Place an oven rack in the middle of the oven. Preheat oven to 350°F.
- 2. Spray muffin pan with nonstick cooking spray and set aside.
- 3. In a large bowl, stir together eggs, applesauce, granulated sugar, and vanilla extract.
- 4. In a separate bowl, stir together flour, salt, baking soda, cinnamon, ginger, and cloves.
- 5. Stir flour mixture into egg mixture until just barely blended.
- 6. Gently stir in zucchinis, raisins, and nuts.
- 7. Divide batter evenly among muffin cups.
- 8. Bake 20 minutes or until a wooden toothpick inserted in the center of a muffin comes out clean.
- 9. Remove muffin pans from oven and let muffins stand for 5 minutes.
- Remove muffins from pan and place them on a wire rack to finish cooling. Serve warm or at room temperature.

Dessert

Banana Ice Cream

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 ½ bananas (ripe)
- 3 Tbsp. milk, 1%
- chocolate syrup (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Peel and slice bananas into medium size round pieces. Place on a plastic wrap covered baking sheet and put in freezer overnight.
- 2. Place frozen bananas in a food processor or blender with a small splash of milk (not over ¼ cup total).
- 3. Pulse food processor or blender until bananas begin to break up. They will be tiny balls of bananas at this point.
- 4. Using a spoon or rubber spatula, scrape down the banana mixture. Continue running the food processor until the mixture is smooth and creamy. This may take a few minutes. The ice cream will look and taste like soft serve ice cream when finished.
- 5. Serve in an ice cream cone or in a small bowl with a small ribbon of chocolate syrup on top (optional)
