Statewide Medical and Health Exercise, November 17, 8:00am – 2:00pm

Multiple locations include the Operational Area Emergency Operations Center (OA EOC), Department Operations Centers (DOCs), Hospital Command Centers (HCCs), local jurisdiction and other healthcare facility command centers.

Exercise Purpose: Operationally address and coordinate response functions of EMS and Public Health to a mass casualty incident (MCI), to include coordinated command and control as well as the coordination of response functions with transport providers, Hospitals, Long Term Care Facilities and Clinics.

Exercise Goals:

1. Activate the OA EOC, HCSA DOC, HCCs and other command centers to evaluate Operational Area medical and health capabilities and healthcare partner coordination (*Emergency Operations Coordination*).
2. Evaluate healthcare partner roles, responsibilities and capabilities during a medical surge event requiring healthcare system expansion and decompression (*Medical Surge*).
3. Address triage, patient distribution and tracking and activation of mutual aid (*Medical Surge*).
4. Utilize a number of communications systems to evaluate sharing of actionable information (*Information Sharing*).

Please Note: The HCSA DOC will be activated for several weeks prior to the functional exercise to coordinate flu season activities with community partners and monitor healthcare partner vaccination rates. The HCSA DOC will then transition to support the Operational Area EOC in Dublin for the MCI scenario.
