FUNCTIONAL EXERCISE: THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 8:00AM - 2:00 PM

MULTIPLE LOCATIONS: OA Emergency Operations Center (EOC), Department Operations Centers (DOCs); Local Jurisdiction EOC/DOCs; Hospital Command Centers (HCCs); Fire Department and Ambulance Providers; and other healthcare facilities command centers (including Skilled Nursing Facilities and Clinics).

GOALS

1. Activate the OA EOC, HCSA DOC, HCCs and other command centers to evaluate Operational Area medical and health capabilities and healthcare partner coordination (**Emergency Operations Coordination**)
2. Evaluate healthcare partner roles, responsibilities and capabilities during a medical surge event requiring healthcare system expansion and decompression. (**Medical Surge**)
3. Operationally address EMS field provider scene response, triage, patient movement, patient distribution, tracking and activation of mutual aid. (**Medical Surge**)
4. Utilize redundant communications systems to evaluate sharing of actionable information, e.g. ReddiNet and CAHAN. (**Medical Surge**)
