Laboratory Report

- Alameda County's Public Health Laboratory (ACPHL) is a Federal and State Certified Infectious Disease Laboratory.
- The ACPHL has extensive experience with influenza testing:
 - Able to test for influenza by PCR (rapid, highly sensitive, testing) for flu surveillance, current lab clients, and in outbreak settings or unusual concerning exposures if needed
 - Capable of *sub-typing the virus*; (distinguishing H5, H7, H1 etc.)

Information & Guidance

Seasonal Influenza Information

- CA Dept of Public Health confirmed the first flu death in an infant, and the first report of an adult death <65 years
 of age this season. The influenza-associated infant death occurred in Stanislaus County in a child who was too
 young to be immunized. CDPH also released the <u>2014-15 California Influenza Surveillance Report</u> stating that there
 were 78 influenza-associated deaths reported in persons under age 65 last year. These data underscore the
 seriousness of influenza disease and the importance of vaccination in all persons age 6 months and older.
- Media interview by KTVU occurred on 11/5th at one elementary school with Dr. Erica Pan about this year's flu vaccine and upcoming flu season.
