Please ask for Tony Barbosa. You can either fill-out this form beforehand and bring it with you or fill it out at the Alameda County Public Health Department offices.

All rental periods are for four weeks. In order to extend the due date, please call Tony Barbosa. We will provide extensions when there is no one is waiting to borrow a copy of the DVD.

Late/Lost DVDs

While the DVD rental is free, in order to ensure that the DVDs are returned, we require that the person/organization renting the DVD leave a deposit for the full cost of replacing the DVD, which is \$295.00.
