

# Where Do I VOTE?

Follow the steps below to make sure your vote is counted in this election!

- **Mail Your Ballot or Drop it in a Secure Ballot Box!**

- If you received a ballot by mail, you seal it and mail it through US Postal Service, postmarked by Tuesday November 5.
- **Tip:** Make sure your signature and name look like the signature on your driver's license.
- Or drop your ballot in a Secure Drop Box. Open 24-hr/day until 8pm, Tuesday Nov 5. Scan for map of Secure Dropboxes:



**Nearest Secure Drop Box:**

- **Vote or Drop off Ballot in Person!**

- You can vote In-Person at one of Alameda County's Accessible Voting Locations, October 25<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday Nov 5<sup>th</sup> at 8pm.
- Scan for a map of 11-day and 4-day Accessible Voting Locations:

# YOU CAN STILL REGISTER AND VOTE IN PERSON!

- Go in person to any Accessible Voting Location (Oct 25-Nov 5)
- You do not need to have ID, just tell them the last 4 numbers of your social security # or Driver's License/ID number, a mailing address and a place of residence address. Then you will get a ballot to fill and submit.
