
Where Do I VOTE?

Follow the steps below to make sure your vote is counted in this election!

Mail Your Ballot or Drop it in a Secure Ballot Box!

- If you received a ballot by mail, you can seal it and mail it through US Postal Service, postmarked by Tuesday November 5.
- Tip: Make sure your signature and name look like the signature on your driver's license.

Vote or Drop off Ballot in Person!

- You can vote In-Person at one of Alameda County's Accessible Voting Locations, Saturday Oct 31 through 8pm Tuesday Nov 5.

Voting Centers are open 9am-5pm most days but 7am-8pm on Election Day

- o Go in person to any Accessible Voting Location (Oct 25-Nov 5)
- You don't need ID, just tell them the last 4 numbers of your social security # or Driver's License/ID number, a mailing address and a place of residence address.
 Then you will get a ballot to fill and submit.
