

# Exercise Your Right to VOTE in 2024!

If you are experiencing homelessness, you can register and vote in the November Elections!



You are eligible to vote in Alameda County if you are:

- A U.S. citizen
- A resident of Alameda County
- 18 years or older on Election Day (November 5, 2024)
- Not currently in prison or on parole for a felony conviction

The last day to register to vote in the upcoming election is **October 21, 2024**. But if you don't register, you can **STILL** Vote before or on November 5th!

## All you need to complete your voter registration is:

- A **mailing address** where you can receive your ballot
- Any **residence address** (even if it's an outside location)
- **Either** the last 4 digits of your social security number **or** California ID/CDL number



## Verify or change your voter registration:

## DID YOU KNOW?

- **ALL registered voters in California will receive a Mail-In Ballot** sent to them before election day (November 5, 2024)
- You can either mail-in your ballot OR drop it off at an official ballot drop-box or at a Voting Center
- You can also register and vote in-person at one of Alameda County's Accessible Voting Centers starting October 26 until November 5<sup>th</sup> at 8pm.
